- Paraphrase important PLOT EVENTS—bullet points or notes in the margins (at least 3 per chapter)

  2. Complete a “One-Pager” following the instructions found on [www.edslibrary.org](http://www.edslibrary.org). There are instructions, a checklist, and examples to help you with the project. This project will be used to show your understanding of the book.
