

8th Grade Summer Reading Requirements

PART 1 (REQUIRED):

- 1. Choose one of the following books to read: *The Outsiders* by S.E. Hinton, *Ghost* by Jason Reynolds, *or Rules of the Road* by Joan Bauer.
- 2. Write or type a double-spaced, <u>one-page summary</u> of the book's plot.
- 3. <u>Turn in the book and summary</u> to the teacher by the **second Friday of the school year**. Write your name on the book. You will receive a <u>50-point grade for annotations and summary</u> and participate in a <u>book club</u> with peers during class.

Annotation Color Codes

*****Quantity Expectations: Aim to use each color** <u>at least five times</u> throughout the book. <u>Yellow</u>- Highlight <u>CONFLICTS</u> (both internal and external) within the book.

Green- Identify and highlight <u>10 VOCABULARY WORDS</u> you do not know and define them within the context of the book. You may define them in the margins or on a separate sheet of paper.

Pink- Highlight examples of <u>HEROIC ACTIONS</u> in the book. Heroic actions are open to interpretation. They can include superhuman feats as well as a person taking on extra responsibilities to help others. **Blue**- Highlight the use of <u>FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE</u> within the book and identify the type. (Imagery, metaphor, simile, personification, hyperbole, onomatopoeia, etc.). Aim to find <u>at least one of each type</u> of figurative language.

Orange-Highlight CHARACTERIZATION details.

PART 2 (Optional Extra Credit Assignment):

***This will be the <u>only opportunity to earn extra credit for the first quarter</u>. You can earn up to 20 points if you meet the assignment's criteria.

- 1. Read a <u>book of your choice</u>. It must have an interest level for "middle grade readers" or higher. (*Diary of a Wimpy Kid* and *Dog Man*, as well as similar book series, are not permitted.)
- 2. Nonfiction books are prohibited due to the nature of the assignment.
- 3. Complete the "Novel Dodecagon Craft-Activity" following the instructions and using the template found at <u>www.edslibrary.org.</u>
- 4. This project should demonstrate your understanding of the book, and you *may* present your dodecagon if you like. It will be displayed in the classroom.
